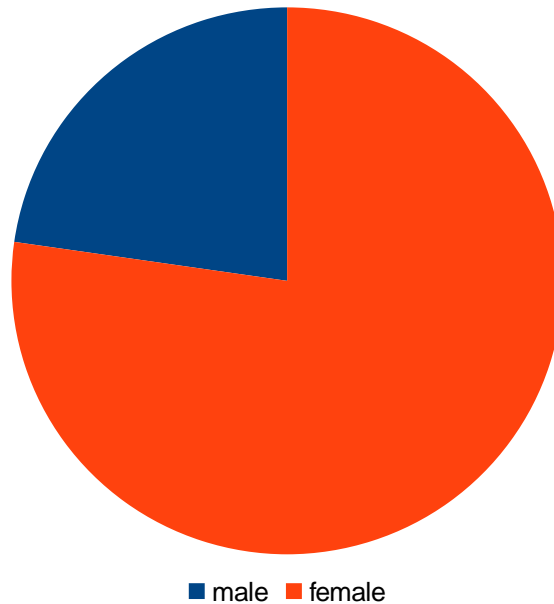

Personal details of the students

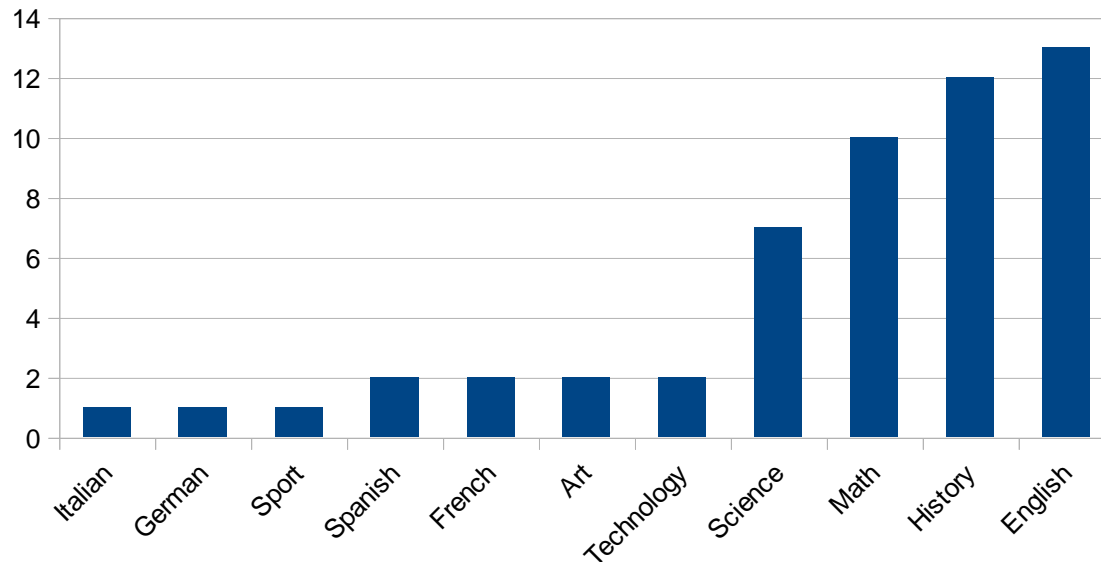


In the 4ème and 3ème euro class, we can see that there are more girls (34) than boys (10). This option seems to be more attractive for girls.

A lot of students like English, History, Maths and Science.

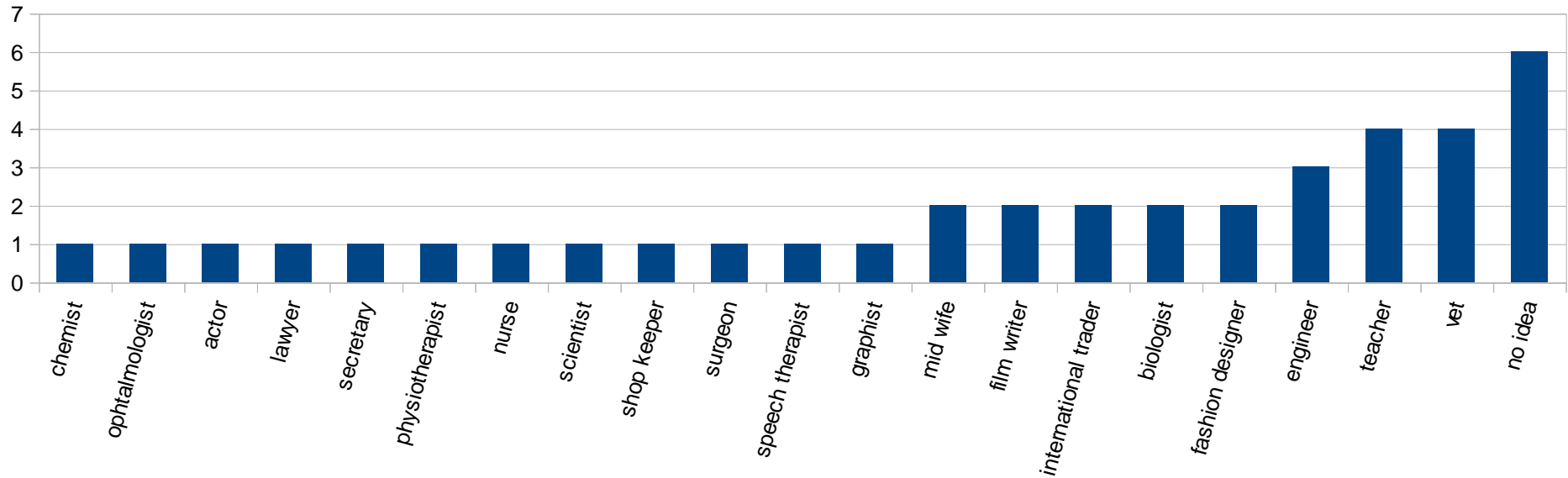
Less people like Spanish, French, Art and Technology.

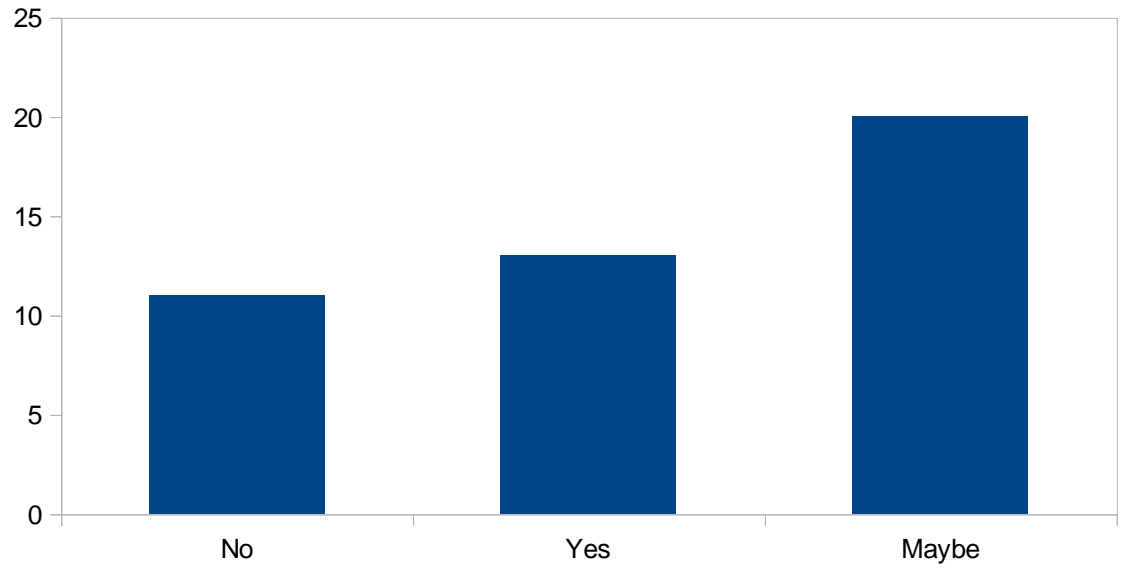
Future job

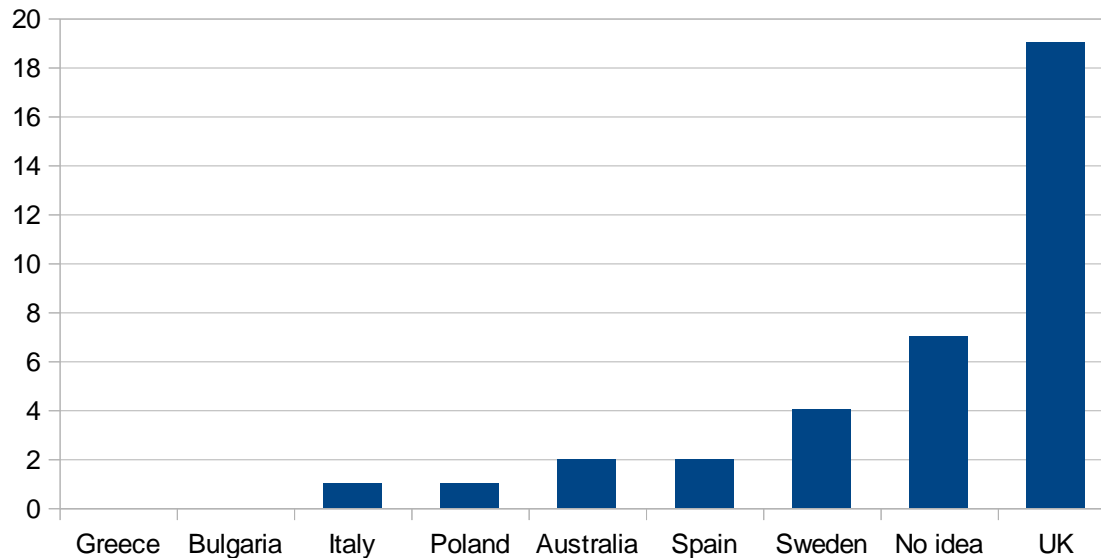
Would you choose to study in another European country ?

If yes, which country would you choose ?

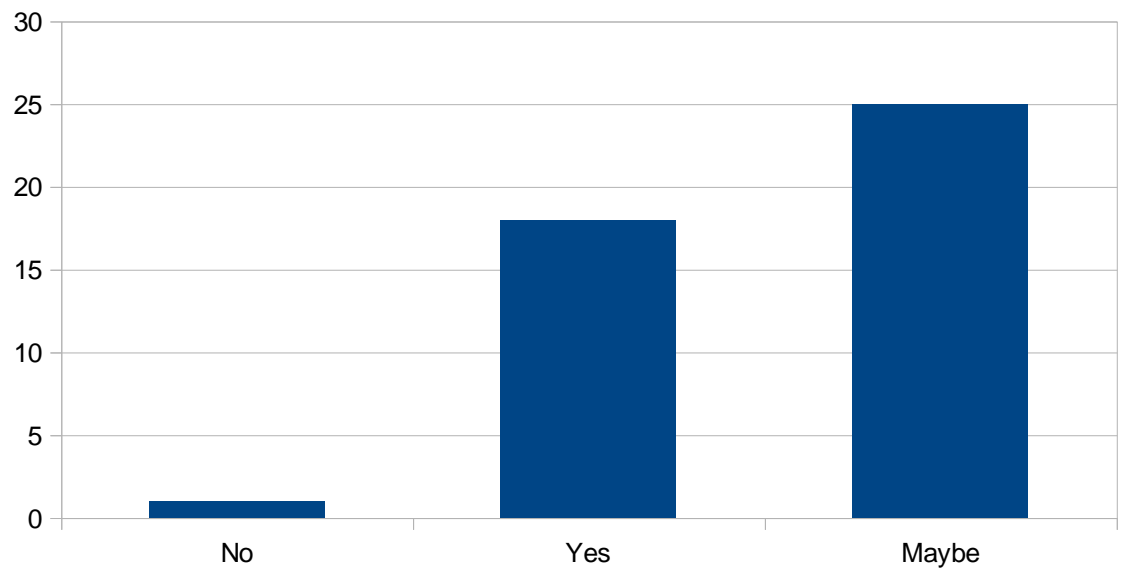


Most of the students want to study in UK which seems the most attractive country as they speak a little bit of English. They have all had a trip in the

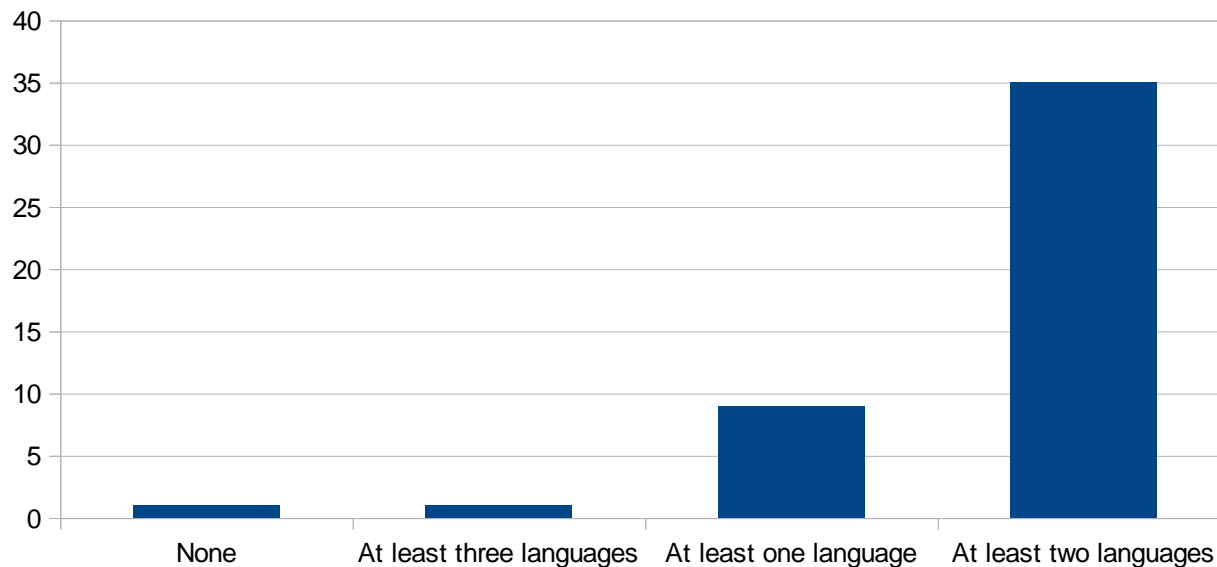
If you had the chance would work in a foreign country?

For the 4eme they have been learning one foreign languages for 3 years and a second one for one year.

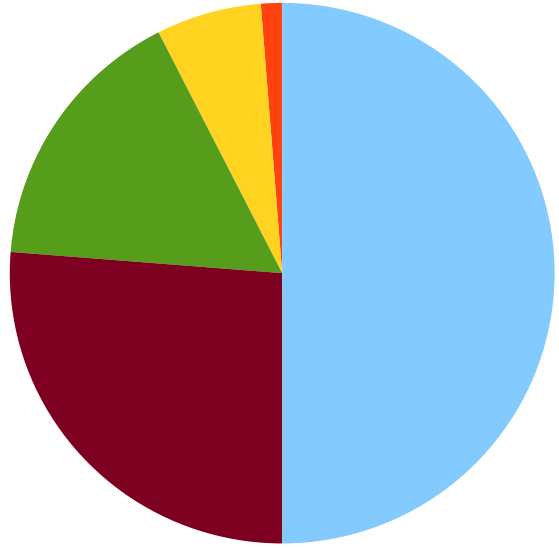
For the 3ème they have been learning one foreign languages for 4 years and a second one for two years.

■ Russian ■ Portuguese ■ German ■ Italian ■ Spanish ■ English

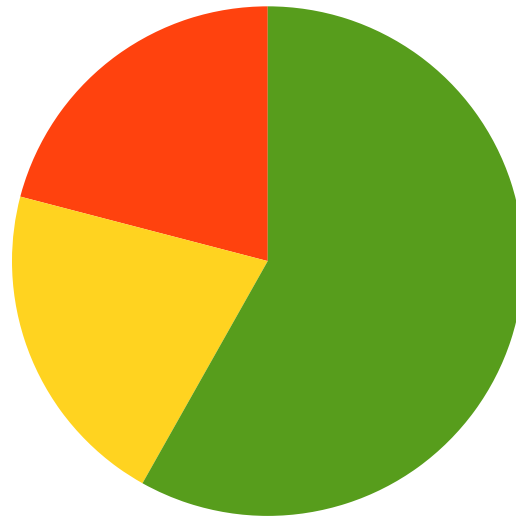


The students speak the languages they learn at school (except portuguese for one student)

Number of languages people should be able to speak in the future

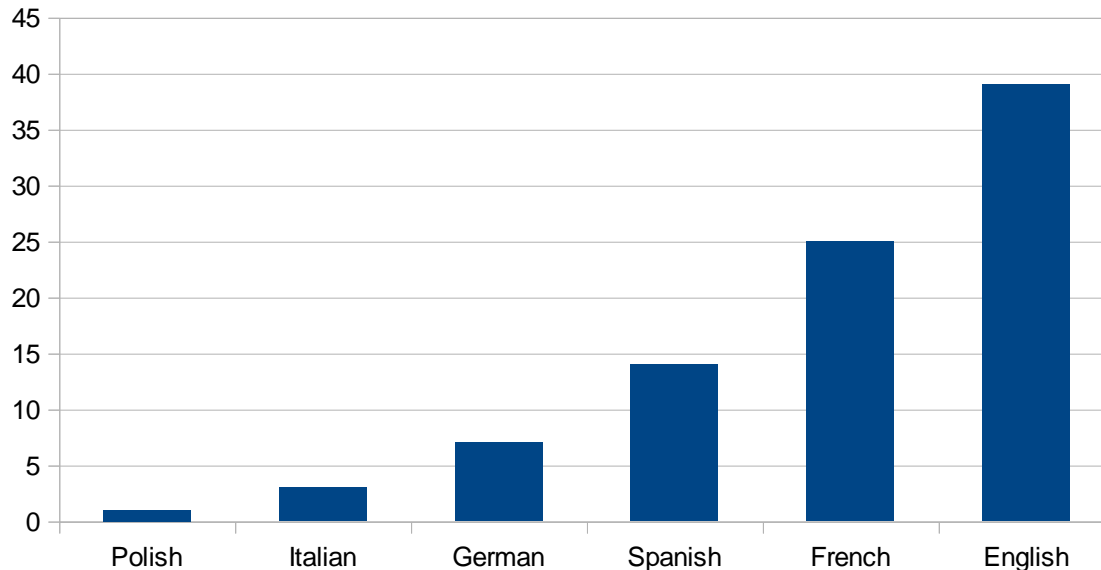
■ None ■ At least one language

Which languages would you prefer to speak ?

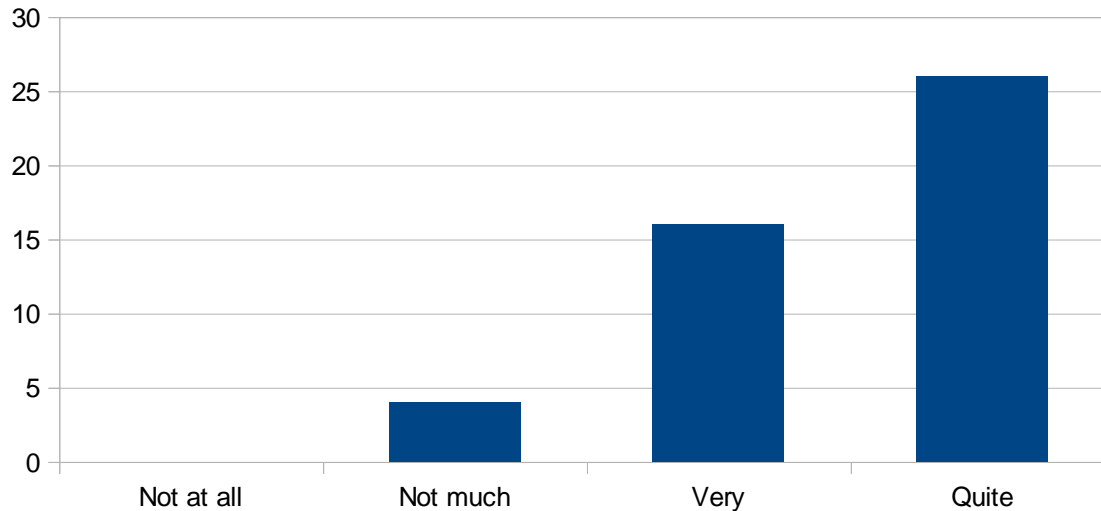

Are you satisfied with the way of living in your country ?

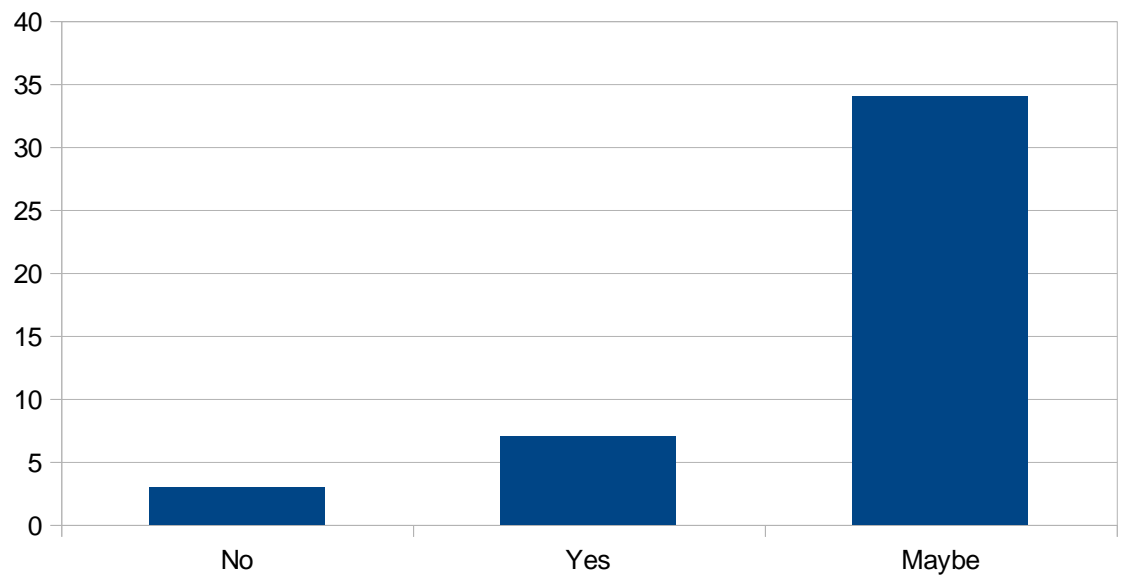


Most of the students are quite happy about the way of living in France.

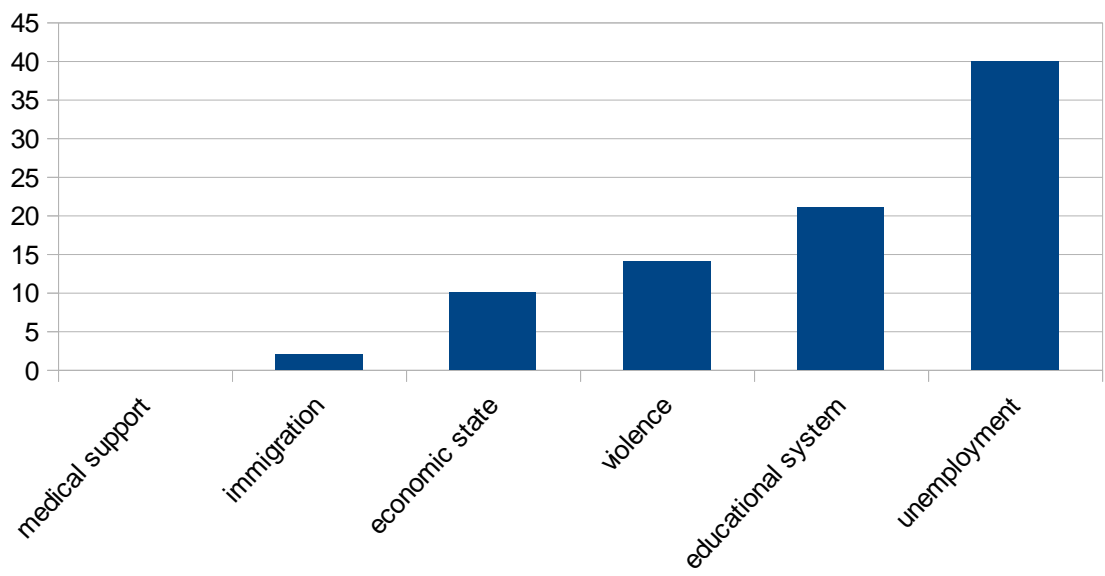
Do you think you will manage to live a better life than that of your parents ?

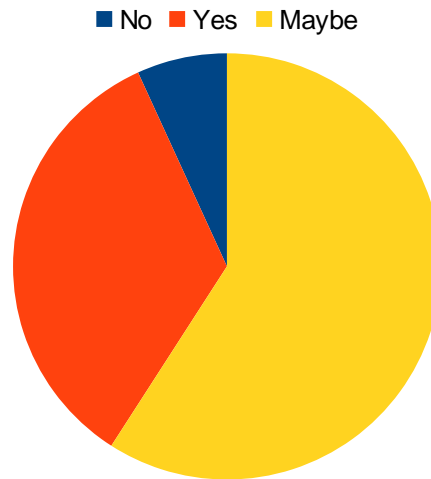
Which are the two most important problems your country has to deal with ?
